

# 2011 Libertyville Cup General Information

The 2011 Libertyville Cup Youth Soccer Festival is an approved tournament of the Illinois Youth Soccer Association – affiliated with USYSA, USSF, and FIFA. The 2011 Libertyville Cup tournament is sanctioned to host teams from the US only. Due to the recent policy change with USYSA, Canadian teams fall under the jurisdiction of international teams and therefore do not qualify for entry into the Cup.

## AGE GROUPS AND LEVELS OF PLAY

The Libertyville Cup Tournament has become one of the best and most popular tournaments in the Midwest. The 2010 Tournament consisted of 380 teams from all over the Midwest participating in multiple levels of competition within each age group. In order to better serve attending clubs, we are once again offering flights for High School Aged boys teams, the age groups are as follows:

U8 (August 1, 2002 and younger)	U14 (August 1, 1996 and younger)
U9 (August 1, 2001 and younger)	U15 (August 1, 1995 and younger)
U10 (August 1, 2000 and younger)	U16 (August 1, 1994 and younger)
U11 (August 1, 1999 and younger)	U17 (August 1, 1993 and younger)
U12 (August 1, 1998 and younger)	U19 (August 1, 1991 and younger)
U13 (August 1, 1997 and younger)	

**RED Flight:** Flight consists of top level club teams and highly competitive “A” level teams.

**WHITE Flight:** Flight consists of second or mid level community based teams.

**BLUE Flight:** Flight consists of third or lower level community based teams.

Girls: U8-U14, All Flights as applications allow.

Boys: U8-U14, All Flights as applications allow.

Boys: U15-U19 – One flight per age group or as competitive balance allows.

## TEAM PARTICIPATION, REFEREE SYSTEMS AND GUEST PLAYERS

U8 -U10 teams may have a maximum roster of 14 players,

U11-U12 teams - maximum of 16 players,

U13-U14 teams - maximum of 18 players,

U15-U19 – maximum of 22 players (only 18 are allowed to dress for any one game).

U8 - U10 teams will play 7v7 on small size fields, 1 man referee system

U11 & U12\* teams will play 9v9 on intermediate size fields, 2 man referee system

U13-U19 teams will play 11v11 on full size fields, 3 man referee system

\*U12 teams will have the option to play 9v9 or 11v11, please choose correct format when registering.

The team or teams must be entered for competition in a league affiliated with the USSF or national equivalent and sanctioned by the appropriate State or National Association. State and National Select teams are not eligible. Prior to competition, teams must present proof of affiliation and permission to travel (out of state teams).

Validated, laminated State player passes, as well as parental medical release forms, are required for all players participating in the tournament.

Teams are allowed 3 passed coaches on bench. Each coach in the bench area must be licensed and passed, and is responsible for his/her team and spectators at each game. In the event a coach with a valid pass is not available to start a game, GLSA will provide a passed coach (for a fee – to be charged to the team/club). Any team not having a passed coach at the beginning of the game will have until the end of halftime to provide a passed coach or the game at hand will be forfeited (see Forfeit section for impact of forfeiting a game). The appointed GLSA coach will stay with the team through the second half to allow the players to complete the game.

A maximum of three guest players is allowed (players from same club are not considered guest players). Teams need no prior approval for guest players. Forms for guest players can be attained through state association. Questions regarding guest players should be directed to the Tournament Director.

## AWARDS

Participation Medals will be given to all U8 and U9 players. Team and individual awards will be presented to Champions and Runners-up, for U10- U19 age divisions, in all flights. After Championship matches, please have teams report to stage area for awards presentation. All players will receive a tournament program guide and patch commemorating the event. In addition, the traditional exchange of club pins or patches among teams is strongly encouraged.

## APPLICATION PROCESS

If you wish to participate in the 2009 Libertyville Cup Youth Soccer Festival, please complete an application in its entirety and return it with the entry fee of as follows (US currency):

U8-U10 (7v7) - \$500

U11-U12 (9v9) - \$550

U12-U19 (11v11) - \$575

The application and fee **MUST BE IN THE HANDS** of the Tournament Director by **April 18, 2011**.

Those teams not accepted into the tournament will have their entry fee returned with their letter of non-acceptance. Any team that withdraws from the tournament after being accepted will forfeit their fee.
